



A Readers' Guide to TomeRaider 3 ISV

TomeRaider 3 is an ebook reader that can be used to read and search the ISV New Testament. It can be used just like a concordance to select passages containing a particular word. There are separate versions of the TomeRaider 3 software for Windows PCs, Palm and Pocket PC devices.

To read the ISV New Testament with TomeRaider 3 you will need to:

1. Download the ISV New Testament in TomeRaider 3 format from www.isv.org at the page <http://isv.org/downloads/index.htm#electronic> then unzip the archive file that arrives.
2. For Windows PCs download the TomeRaider 3 software from www.proporta.com or www.tomeraider.com , unzip it and double click on the .exe file to install the program on your computer. For Windows choose between the traditional-look Legacy version and the new Plus version. It costs around \$20 per copy to register. An unlock code will be sent by email when you have paid.

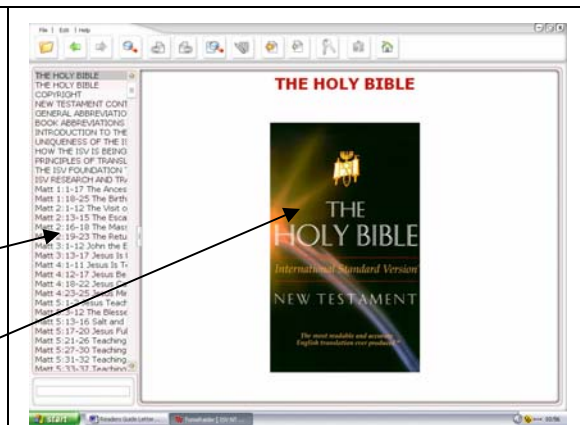
This Guide deals only with the use of TomeRaider 3 on Windows PCs. Illustrations below show the Plus version of TomeRaider 3 running on a PC.

TomeRaider 3 can open documents produced by earlier versions of TomeRaider. It converts them to TomeRaider 3 format automatically and saves the version 3 document. Selected free TomeRaider documents are available for download on www.tomeraider.com but the principal free TomeRaider library is at www.memoware.com .

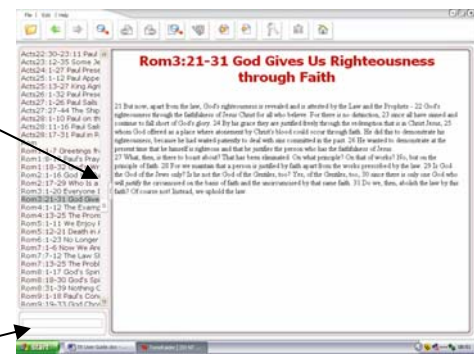
To start reading the ISV New Testament with TomeRaider 3:

Double click on the TR icon on the Windows desktop. When TomeRaider 3 has started, click on FILE at the top left-hand corner and open the ISV New Testament as you would open a Word document.

The left hand side of the screen shows the Subject View (ISV section headings) while the right hand is the Page View (text of the selected ISV section).



Go to the passage you wish to read by dragging the scroll bar in the Subject View down and up, and clicking on the section required.

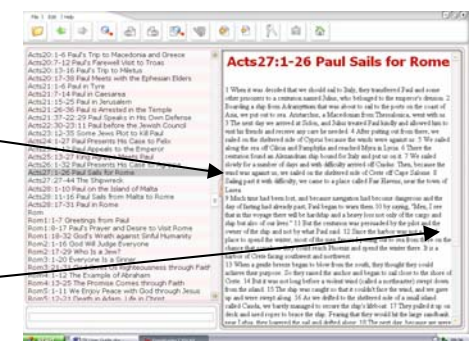


Turn the page by clicking on the next section heading in the Subject View.

Go to the start of a different New Testament book by entering the appropriate abbreviation in the Subject Lookup box.

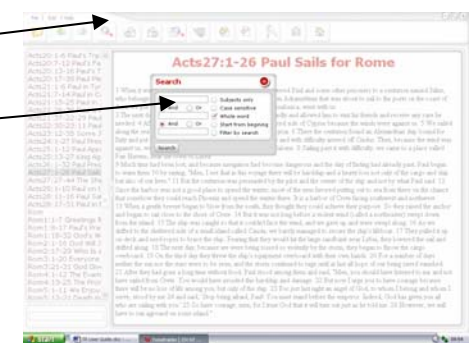
See ISV introductory pages for abbreviations.

To change the division of window width between the Subject View and Page View drag the button on the Page View right or left.



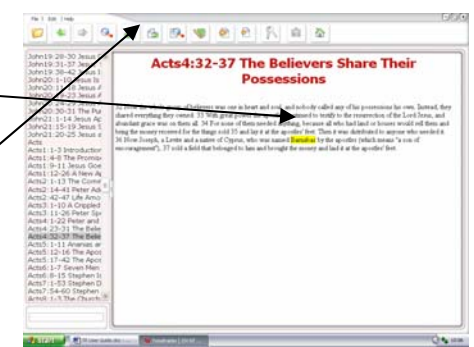
If the text shown in Page View overflows on to a new page, use the scroll bar to turn the page.

To search the text for a particular word click on the START SEARCH icon.



A search box slides in from the right. After entering the search criteria click on SEARCH.

A search for “Barnabas” will show the first occurrence of the word in the New Testament. Note that the word is highlighted.

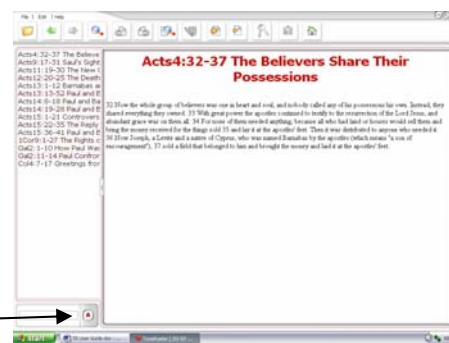


To see other references to the word in turn click on the FIND THE NEXT PAGE icon.

The icon to the left of that icon is FIND THE PREVIOUS PAGE.

To use TomeRaider 3 as a concordance and show just the sections of text containing the word searched for, tick **FILTER BY SEARCH** in the Search box. If “Barnabas” is searched for the result is shown here.

To clear the filter and show all subjects in the Subject View click on the **A** button at the end of the Subject Lookup box.



TomeRaider3 has an online user manual. To read this click on **HELP** on the menu bar at the top of the screen, then click on **MANUAL**. The manual is a TomeRaider3 file and when this is opened TomeRaider3 closes the New Testament. It is necessary to open the New Testament again by clicking on **FILE**, and opening the file.
